Sacral Neuromodulation
Provides gentle stimulation to the nerves that control the bladder and bowel, restoring normal communication to the brain.
Clean Intermittent Self-catherization
A procedure in which the patient will insert a catheter (a thin hollow tube) into your bladder to help you urinate.
Surgical Intervention
The type of surgical procedure available as an advanced treatment option is dependent on the cause of your condition. Refer to your physician for more information.
